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## Chaparral Student Awarded the Flinn Scholarship

Natola He, a senior at Chaparral High School, was awarded the Flinn Scholarship, which provides 20 of Arizona's highest-achieving students an unparalleled package for undergraduate study. In partnership with Arizona's three state universities, the program develops enriched educational experiences to expand scholars' life and career options, while creating the challenging educational environment that students experience at the nation's most selective colleges. The scholarship helps students achieve their most ambitious educational goals by underwriting tuition and living expenses and providing an allowance for international study.

The Flinn Scholarship also provides the full cost of tuition and fees for four years at an Arizona public university; a three-week overseas seminar plus two additional summers or semesters of international study-related travel and professional development; personal mentoring by university faculty and Flinn Foundation professionals; Public policy seminars on timely

**Desert Mountain Complex: Community Forum**  
**April 7, 2008**  
**Community Discussion Groups**

1. Choice schools pay tuition to defray costs
2. All bus students pay \$1/day
3. Choice school students' parents provide their transportation similar to open enrollment parents
4. Close SUSD offices, move administration to campuses that are under-utilized
5. All elementary schools K-6 (increases enrollment at all elementary schools)
6. Mountainside becomes 7, 8 and 9<sup>th</sup> grade (9<sup>th</sup> grade still has access to gym and track). DMHS is 10-11-12 leaving plenty of room for MMR students.
7. Generate money by selling the empty warehouse and bus lots
8. Run the district like a business. All principals run their own facility. Create action plan/maintain budget.
9. Combine DCMS and CRMS at either CRMS or DCMS campus. Then move Cheyenne to whichever one is empty.
10. No retroactive salary raises
11. Dissolve marketing department at SUSD or shift marketing monies to each school for schools to market themselves

**Chaparral Complex: Community Forum**  
**March 20, 2008**  
**Community Discussion Groups**

1. Aztec, Zuni, Cheyenne, DCES, Hohokam, Navajo, Pima, DCMS
2. Communicate classroom capacity accurately with special programs up thru grade 8
  - Gifted
  - PE
  - Panda
  - Preschool
  - Etc!
3. Desert Canyon becomes K-8 (using both campuses) to include new preschool
  - Aztec continues thematic instruction
  - Zuni becomes K-8 but remains with specials programs up thru grade 8
4. By making these schools K-8, they can feed to separate high schools
5. Move 6-8 Cheyenne to Desert Canyon MS or Mountainside MS – let them create houses for different philosophies
6. All K-8s use DCMS on rotating schedule
