THE PROCESS

- Continuation of our update of Board Policy Manual
- Pursuant to recommendations from Arizona School Boards Association (ASBA)
- With input from appropriate Departments

STATUS

- We have completed recommended revisions to Sections A-D

POLICIES PRESENTED TONIGHT

- Presenting recommended revisions to remaining policies in Sections I & J for a first read

SECTION I HIGHLIGHT (First Read)

- Policy IL: Evaluation of Instructional Programs
 - Updates policy regarding administration of standardized test participation for students, grades two through twelve, and appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities

SECTION I HIGHLIGHT (First Read)

- Policy IL: Evaluation of Instructional Programs (cont'd)
 - Recommended change also adds statement that "All students will be assessed during the testing window that is established by the District to ensure compliance with State and Federal guidelines."

SECTION J HIGHLIGHTS (First Read)

- Policy JFBA: Unsafe School Choice
 - Adds policy explaining and defining “unsafe school choice” pursuant to NCLB

SECTION J HIGHLIGHTS (First Read)

- JLIF: Sex Offender Notification
 - Sets forth law regarding sex offender notification and states that the District procedures shall encompass measures to disseminate information to staff and parents and measures to provide teachers, parents information regarding juveniles who have been convicted of “dangerous offenses” or sex offenses

- Bring back for second read and possible Board approval
- Continue receiving feedback from Departments present remaining recommended changes
