Notice is hereby given to the members of the Governing Board and to the general public that on **Tuesday, June 16, 2009, immediately following the regularly scheduled Board Meeting, in the Education Center Board Room, 3811 North 44th Street, Phoenix, Arizona**, the Governing Board will hold a Special Meeting and pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.02, may vote to convene in Executive Session. If authorized by majority vote of the Governing Board, the Executive Session will be held immediately after the vote. The Executive Session will not be open to the public.

All persons present at an Executive Session are hereby reminded that A.R.S. §38-431.03 imposes strict confidentiality requirements on discussions that occur in Executive Session. Generally, such discussions cannot be revealed to non-board members, unless necessary to carry out the purpose of the statutory provision that specifically permits an Executive Session. The Open Meeting Law provides for a fine of up to \$500 for violating this confidentiality requirement, and requires that this admonition be given.

 - A. Discussion and consideration for legal advice with the attorneys of the Governing Board and to consider its position and instruct its attorneys regarding pending litigation, pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3) and (4).

Discussion/consultation with the Board's designated representatives in order to consider the Board's position and instruct its representatives regarding negotiations with employee organization(s) regarding the salaries, salary schedules or compensation paid in the form of fringe benefits of its employees and other terms and conditions of employment, so that those representatives can properly represent the Board in upcoming "Meet and Confer" sessions, pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(5).
