SUSD now issues high school credit towards graduation for students successfully completing Algebra 1 during their middle school years. In addition to the credit, students will earn grade points towards their high school Grade Point Average (GPA).

Middle school Algebra 1 is as rigorous as high school Algebra 1. The state standards are thoroughly covered plus extension activities are available to help students prepare for the rigor of high school honors mathematics.

The guidelines for curriculum, instruction, assessment, and record keeping that frame high school Algebra 1, also apply to middle school Algebra 1.
