Welcome to the PANDA Preschool Program

The PANDA acronym represents Program for Assessed Needs in Developmental Areas.



PANDA provides a quality preschool program for all children. In each class there are a few openings for peer models. The peer models are typically developing children who are enrolled in the PANDA program to provide strong language and behavioral models for the special needs preschoolers.

PANDA is a child-centered program emphasizing individual growth, development and achievement. We believe that a quality preschool experience for all children will greatly enhance their social, language, motor and pre-academic skills for Kindergarten .

Each child who enters the preschool program brings a unique variety of experiences and skills that are incorporated in the program.

We believe that collaboration and communication are key to an effective preschool program. Therefore, parental involvement is essential in planning and implementing the preschool program.

We believe that the PANDA staff represents the highest quality of professional expectations. For this reason, the PANDA program closely adheres to the developmentally appropriate practices supported by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). In addition, we implement the well-researched instructional standards formulated by the Arizona Department of Education. In combining these practices, we are able to provide an outstanding preschool experience for all children.



Class times: Each class operates 4 days a week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday) for 2 hours 45 minutes in a morning or an afternoon session. Contact school for exact class times.

Class size: The maximum class size is 12 with at least 3 teaching staff. Each class has an Arizona Certified Teacher in Early Childhood.

Cost & Transportation

The fee is \$30 per week and parents must provide transportation.

Children must :

- Turn three by Sept 1
- Toilet trained
- Participate in preschool screening

Enrollment:

- Open enrollment to out of district student is available if there is space.
- Transportation is not provided.
