



Open Enrollment Procedures for 2009-10 Notice to Parents

December 1, 2008

Open Enrollment applications received between December 1, 2008 and January 15, 2009 will be acted upon based on the Scottsdale Unified School District (SUSD) projected enrollment figures and Board-approved staffing levels and loads for the 2009-10 school year.

With the implementation of the Scottsdale Unified School District open enrollment policy JFB, it is no longer necessary to reapply for open enrollment every school year once your application has been approved, provided that students accepted through open enrollment are continuously enrolled in SUSD. Therefore students approved for open enrollment will follow the feeder pattern established by the District for the school in which they open enroll.

All siblings of students who were open enrolled in a school before the 2006-07 academic year and continuously thereafter, may enroll at the same school, provided that a sibling will still be enrolled there when they arrive. Such siblings will be enrolled regardless of whether the relevant school or grade level is determined closed due to capacity.

The two categories for open enrollment are:

- Category 1: Siblings of students accepted for open enrollment in the 2006-07 academic year or thereafter, whose enrollment will be concurrent with their sibling's at the same school. This category will also include children of regular benefited SUSD employees.
- Category 2: Students who are not enrolled in the school during the current school year.

Within these categories, within District open enrollment applications are given priority over out of District open enrollment applications.

Note: If a category contains too many students at a site to allow acceptance of the entire group, the District will accept students from Category 1 on a first come, first serve basis. The District will then use a lottery to select Students from Category 2.

Timeline waiver: Applications for open enrollment received after the January 15 deadline will be dated, filed, and considered only after students whose applications were submitted by the deadline are enrolled.

Please note that while all campuses are open to open enrollment, capacity may vary by grade level and program type. Schools indicated below by an asterisk (*) are currently at program capacity for some grade levels and programs, therefore students wishing to open enroll will be placed on a waiting list for those grades and programs. In order to determine open enrollment availability, please contact each school directly.
