SOUTHERN SCOTTSDALE AND GREATER AIRPARK AREA VISIONING WORKSHOPS

The City of Scottsdale is in the process of updating its General Plan. In preparation for this process the City has identified six “Community Areas” within the City. A Community Area Plan will be prepared for each of the six areas, including Southern Scottsdale and the Greater Airpark Area, to ensure that the long term vision for Scottsdale is completed with the 2011 General Plan Update.

The Community Area Plans will include long-range goals for the areas, plus policies to help achieve those goals. Some of the topics that will be addressed are: land use, transportation, economic vitality and regional connectivity.

Scottsdale residents and stakeholders are invited to provide ideas and feedback for creation of these Community Area Plans, documents that will guide future development and redevelopment in Southern Scottsdale and the Greater Airpark Area.

The City of Scottsdale Advance Planning Team is hosting workshops on May 7th and May 8th on the Southern Scottsdale Community Area Plan. The purpose of the workshops is to allow the community to hear the results from the Vision Week workshops that occurred March 26th – 29th. Community members will have an opportunity to weigh-in on the vision themes and priorities that are most important for Southern Scottsdale.
