Staffing

- 68 CHS positions
 - 64 teachers
 - 1 librarian
 - 3 counselors
- 54 CHS teachers were interviewed
- 34 CHS teachers were offered contracts
- 29 signed contracts
- 14 chose to be reassigned



Staffing (cont.)

35 of our 68 are SUSD staff

- 29 currently work at CHS
- 6 SUSD transferred from other schools
- Positions unfilled
 - 1.0 Guidance Counselor (declined contract)
 - 1.0 Math (declined contract)
 - 1.0 Science (contract offered)
 - 1.0 Athletic Director (interviews this week)
- 1.6 unassigned CHS teachers
