Participation and Process

- Code of Conduct Committee comprised of multiple departments, administration, and teacher representation.
- Discussion and feedback from:
 - Student Advisory Board (SAB)
 - Assistant Principals
- Review of Dress Codes from other schools in valley and amongst our three “uniform” schools in SUSD



Student Concerns on Dress Code

- Not fairly/consistently enforced on campus
- Inconsistent application between boys and girls
- Male teachers do not address dress code violation for girls
- Teachers not aware of drug/alcohol trends and signs on clothing (ie. Shirts and hats) that should otherwise violate the Code



Next Steps

- Reinforce current “dress code” and consistently apply between all schools (including schools with uniform);
- Decrease opportunities for “bias”. Educate staff, students, and parents;
- Develop and communicate informational material for students and parents prior to school and throughout the school year. For example: Pictures and/or videos of appropriate attire.
