- 2. Update on Church parking lot. Church does not want cameras on the site. They are asking for a security person in am and pm. They could, at any time, pull the use of their parking lot by students. School is considering charging for parking in the lot to pay for security person. STUGO has discussed a trash committee to have a) Saturday school detention clean up lot or b) have lot close for a day so students will feel impact and hopefully have not appreciation of the parking and clean up after themselves. c) sending student written letters of apology. CHAPS sent a thank you note from the parent committee and will send a gift basket in May. All are working to salvage the church parking lot!*
