Policy JFB, Open Enrollment

- Definitions
 - Resident student
 - Resident transfer student: enrolled in or seeking enrollment in a school within the district, but outside the attendance area. Also children of District employees.
 - Non-resident student

Open Enrollment Capacity

- The Superintendent shall by December 1 of each year, estimate how much excess capacity may exist to accept transfer students and shall submit the estimate of excess capacity to the Board for approval. The estimate of excess capacity shall include estimates for each school, grade level and/or program.

Open Enrollment Priorities

- Category 1: Subject to school, grade level and/or program capacity, enrollment preference shall be given to resident transfer students and children of employees and any sibling who would be enrolled concurrently with such students. If capacity is not sufficient to enroll all of these students, they shall be selected through a selection process adopted by regulation of the Superintendent.

Open Enrollment Priorities

- Category 2: Subject to school, grade level and/or program capacity, enrollment preference shall be given to non-resident students and any sibling who would be enrolled concurrently with such students. If capacity is not sufficient to enroll all of these students, they shall be selected through a selection process adopted by regulation of the Superintendent.
