SUSD Conducts Survey of Stakeholder Communities

SCOTTSDALE, **Ariz**. (October 8, 2018) Parents, students in grades 4-12, employees and the community at-large are invited to help move Scottsdale Unified School District (SUSD) forward by taking part in a confidential, online survey open through October 26.

The climate survey asks SUSD stakeholders to share their opinions about both district and school operations, such as learning and work environments, leadership, communications, safety and allocation of resources.

The survey is being conducted by Hanover Research, an independent, education research firm based in Arlington, Virginia.

SUSD will look to the survey's results to get the pulse of its various stakeholder communities and help inform discussions and decisions about the District's future. School results are expected in early December.
