Notice is hereby given to the members of the Governing Board and to the general public that on **Thursday, December 14, 2017, at 12:00 PM, in the Mohave District Annex, 8500 E. Jackrabbit Road, Scottsdale, Arizona**, the Governing Board will hold a Special Governing Board Meeting and pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.02, may vote to convene in Executive Session. If authorized by majority vote of the Governing Board, the Executive Session will be held immediately after the vote. One or more members of the Governing Board may participate in the meeting by telephonic communication. The Executive Session will not be open to the public.

All persons present at an Executive Session are hereby reminded that A.R.S. §38-431.03 imposes strict confidentiality requirements on discussions that occur in Executive Session. Generally, such discussions cannot be revealed to non-board members, unless necessary to carry out the purpose of the statutory provision that specifically permits an Executive Session. The Open Meeting Law provides for a fine of up to \$500 for violating this confidentiality requirement, and requires that this admonition be given. **Persons with a disability may request reasonable accommodations by contacting Ms. Sondra Como, Executive Assistant to the Governing Board and Superintendent. Accommodations should be requested two working days prior to the meeting to allow time for the District to make arrangements for the accommodation.**
