

ANNE FRANK EXHIBIT COMING TO SUSD

PEER EDUCATION & OPPORTUNITY FOR A THOUGHT-PROVOKING FIELD TRIP

SUSD will host a traveling exhibit called *Anne Frank - A History for Today*. The exhibit tells the story of Anne Frank through photographs and “peer education,” in which students are responsible for the guided tours. Our own SUSD students will explain the content to their fellow students.

Mohave Middle School students selected to serve as guides received special training from the Anne Frank Foundation in March, along with students from Dobson High in Mesa and Carl Hayden High in Phoenix, which will host the exhibit after SUSD. The student guides will be available during school hours, and SUSD schools are invited to plan tours. The exhibit is aimed at HS and upper classes in MS. After-hours tours may be available, as well.

We hope that this effort will motivate teachers and students to engage in a conversation that supports the main premise of the exhibit, that even today, the life of Anne Frank still provides us with valuable lessons.
