Math For Success

Based on State standardized Testing, diagnostic tests and teacher recommendation, students who experience challenges in math may be scheduled to attend a specified academic Math for Success course during the school day in lieu of an elective. This course is designed to provide targeted, structured intervention to students who would benefit from support in Math. This course will focus on remediating skills that are identified on the i-Ready diagnostic using My Path with support from the teacher, SUSD benchmark scores, state assessments, course grades, and teacher recommendation. This is a 9-week course. Teacher/Counselor recommendation needed.
