

Good evening Mohave families, this is Chris Asmussen, Principal calling with weekly announcements.

We will collect library books, textbooks, sports uniforms, musical instruments, choir uniforms, Chromebooks and anything else that belongs to our school on Monday, May 18<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, May 19<sup>th</sup>.

We must collect items from 8<sup>th</sup> grade and any other families that will not be returning to Mohave next year. 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade families that would prefer to turn in items in Late July, just prior to starting next year, have that option. 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade families that checked out Chromebooks may also keep them through the summer, please note that Hot Spots will be deactivated on May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

There is a short video on our website that shows how to check your student's library account. We encourage you to do this so that you are aware of all of the books and resources that need to be returned. Next to the title of the book, there will be a bar code number that should match up to the one on your student's book that you are returning.

We will practice strict physical distancing protocols during this process. We ask that only one adult per family come to the school to turn in their student's belonging. In addition, we will require that all visitors wear a mask. Parents will park their cars and follow signs and directions into our gymnasium where items will be placed onto tables or into boxes. Our staff will not be touching items and will also practice safe physical distancing practices.

On Monday, May 18<sup>th</sup> we invite families with the last names beginning with A through J to come between 7 and 10 AM. While families with the last name beginning with K through Z come to campus between 4 and 7 PM. On Tuesday, May 19<sup>th</sup>, we will invite last names K through Z to come in the morning between 7 and 10 AM and those with last names A through J to come in the afternoon between 4 and 7 PM.

Again,

Monday May 18<sup>th</sup> A – J from 7 to 10 AM and K – Z from 4 to 7 PM and  
Tuesday May 19<sup>th</sup> K – Z from 7 to 10 AM and A – J from 4 to 7 PM.

8<sup>th</sup> grade and families not returning are asked to return items to our school. 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade families that are returning to Mohave next year may opt to return items at the end of July.

Information on the 8<sup>th</sup> grade promotion car parade will also be made available on our website later this week.

Sadly, Lifetouch, our Yearbook publisher informed us that due to COVID 19 they are delayed in printing and shipping, and don't anticipate our yearbooks arriving to Mohave until mid June. We will keep our families posted on when yearbooks will be available.

Finally, I again extend my gratitude to our parents who have become our teaching partners. Our students have adjusted, our students have engaged, and participation remained high.
