Red	High Risk - Recommended Virtual w/ Onsite Support Learning	Red	> 100 cases/100k	> 10%	> 10%
Yellow	Mid Risk - Recommended Hybrid Learning	Yellow	10-100 cases/100k	5-10%	5-10%
Green	Low Risk - Recommended Traditional (In-Person) Learning	Green	< 10 cases/100k	< 5%	< 5%

The recommended learning scenario is based on the zip code's COVID-19 community spread data over two consecutive weeks.

As of October 20, 2020: the recommendation to return to virtual learning is predicated on all three benchmarks (Cases per 100k/Percent Positivity / COVID-like Illness) reaching red status for two or more weeks.

If a school district or other defined school area (e.g., charters) has one or more benchmarks in the Substantial category for two or more weeks, schools should consult with Maricopa County Department of Public Health to determine whether to prepare to transition back to virtual learning with onsite support services.

If a school district or other defined school area (e.g., charters) has **ALL three** benchmarks in the Substantial category for two or more weeks, schools should prepare to transition to virtual learning with onsite support services and consult with Maricopa County Department of Public Health.

92.5% of the students in SUSD live in the fifteen zip codes listed above.
