<ul> <li>Upon receipt of the application &amp; payment you will be able to schedule your child's test date and time. Assessments will take place on June 14<sup>th</sup> &amp; June 15<sup>th</sup> and July 13th &amp; July 14<sup>th</sup> at Oak Campus 7501 E Oak St Scottsdale, AZ 85257.</li> <li>The cost of the assessment, test processing and teacher's time is \$85.00. We accept cash, checks or money orders made out to SUSD.</li> <li>For additional questions regarding Early Entrance Assessment, please contact claudiahernandez@susd.org</li> <li>You will be notified through email the day of the assessment if your child passed the test or if your child did not. If you child passed the test, a letter will be attached that you will need to take to your child's school for enrollment. We will also make contact with the school you selected to let them know you were approved for enrollment into Kindergarten.</li> </ul>					
ARS 15-821. Admission of children; required age  C. If a kindergarten program is maintained, a child is eligible for admission to kindergarten if the child is five years of age. A child is deemed five years of age if the child reaches the age of five before September 1 of the current school year. A child is eligible for admission to first grade if the child is six years of age. A child is deemed six years of age if the child reaches the age of six before September 1 of the current school year. If a child who has not reached the age of five before September 1 of the current school year is admitted to kindergarten and is then readmitted to kindergarten in the following school year, a school district or charter school is not eligible to receive basic state aid on behalf of that child during the child's second year of kindergarten. A school district or charter school may charge tuition for any child who is ineligible for basic state aid pursuant to this subsection. The governing board may admit children who have not reached the required age as prescribed by this subsection if it is determined to be in the best interest of the children. For children entering the first grade, such determination shall be based upon one or more consultations with the parent, parents, guardian or guardians, the children, the teacher and the school principal. Such children must reach the required age of five for kindergarten and six for first grade by January 1 of the current school year.  I understand that the decision of the Early Entrance Committee is final, and there will be no appeal. I also understand that if my child needs to repeat kindergarten the following school year, I will be charged the current pre-kindergarten tuition rate of \$674.00 PER BLOCK for 10 blocks, as set by the SUSD Governing Board.
