## **Student Drop off/Pickup**

Please drop off & pick up in the main office parking lot. Please do not drop off or pick up on Valley View Rd; this area is reserved for school buses including special education transportation. Do not drop your child off on Jackrabbit Rd. The city has posted NO LEFT TURN signs around our campus. Please be aware there will be no left turn onto or from Granite Reef before school from 7:15-7:45 am and after school from 2:20-245 pm. This move is made in an effort to alleviate traffic congestion and to make it safer for our students. Please be aware that the Scottsdale Police Dept. will be ticketing motorists making left turns.
