1. Enrollment: 1866 Student as of today. Staying steady with the 10 day counts.
 - By Grade F-505, S-440, JR-473, Senior-448
 - By Ethnicity by percentages: C-51%, H-37%, AA-5%, A-3%, NA-2.5%
 - Open Enrollment Percentage: Out of District 41% + 9% SUSD OE = 50%
2. Class Size Resolutions after 6/5ths: Concern is uprooting student & student relations and eliminating more disruptions. Q: Where was the disconnect? A: At the end of the year we were at a positive stand with class sizes. District perception and law states there were more room to reach the physical capacity. PTO working with district to create a policy set in stone with the factors involved. Depending on teacher and subjects staffing can be an issues (trying to honor teacher preferences & Sub info)
