NEW: SUSD Technology Device Checkout and Connectivity Activity – Phase III Distribution

Families that need devices and Internet access can check them out on Thursday, March 26 at two sites. We want to ensure we have enough devices for families, so ***this event is intended for families that do not have any devices or access to the Internet.***

Devices can be picked up Thursday, March 26 between 3 and 7 p.m. at:

- Ingleside Middle School: 5402 E. Osborn Rd., Phoenix
- Coronado High School: 7501 E. Virginia Ave., Scottsdale

Before receiving technology items, students or parent/guardians of 5th through 12th grade students will be requested to present the student's Scottsdale Unified school-issued ID and a Government-issued ID, as well as their child's Student ID Number. For students in Kindergarten through 4th grade, the parent/guardian's government identification is sufficient. Once again, ***this check-out day is for families that do not have any devices in the household.***

Please note that:

- **Students will not be required to be online for great lengths of time.**
- **Multiple siblings can share a device.**
