### **SUSD Technology Device Checkout and Connectivity Activity: Phase III Distribution**

Families that need devices and Internet access can check them out on Thursday, March 26 at two sites in the district. *We want to ensure we have enough devices for families, so this event is intended for families that do not have any devices or access to the Internet.* Devices can be picked up on Thursday, March 26 between 3 and 7 p.m. at:

- Ingleside Middle School: 5402 E. Osborn Rd., Phoenix
- Coronado High School: 7501 E. Virginia Ave., Scottsdale

In order to receive technology items, parents/guardians of 5<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students and older students picking up devices themselves will be requested to present their student's Scottsdale Unified school-issued ID, as well as their own government-issued ID (such as a driver's license) and their child's Student ID number. For students in Kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade, the parent's/guardian's government identification is sufficient. Once again, this initial checkout day is for families that do not have any devices in the household.
