Dear Scottsdale Unified School District Families,

On June 19, 2020 [Maricopa County issued a county-wide regulation](#) requiring the county to “mask-up”.

Therefore, it is required that while these orders remain in effect that all employees, students, athletes, coaches, visitors, volunteers and all people on Scottsdale Unified properties will follow these orders by wearing a face mask/covering as outlined in the orders.

If you do not have a face covering, you will not be permitted to enter or remain in any SUSD facility.

To help protect you, our students and the public, Scottsdale Unified staff members will wear a Face Covering while working in areas open to the general public.

- The County regulation covers all municipalities.
- It is intended to mitigate the spread of infectious disease for the protection and preservation of public health.
- It is the policy of Maricopa County that all persons within Maricopa County shall wear face coverings that fully covers a person's nose and mouth.
- The term "Face Covering" includes, but is not limited to, cloth face masks, surgical masks, towels, scarves, and bandanas.
