Elementary Schedule with all at-home Learning Plan C	<p>If conditions require learning at home for all students, a full day of synchronous teaching paired with asynchronous learning time will be provided to students following the in-person learning schedule.</p> <p>A Safe Place to Learn is available for students who need it on their school campus.</p> <p>Early release every Wednesday</p>	<p>The current EDL schedule will continue for students.</p> <p>Early release every Wednesday</p>

Secondary Schedule - Plan B	<p>$\frac{2}{3}$ day in-person learning, with students leaving campus before lunch paired with asynchronous learning in the afternoon.</p>	<p>$\frac{2}{3}$ day with students streaming into classrooms that contain in-person learners paired with</p>

<p>Secondary Schedule - "Plan C" All at-home Learning</p>	<p>All students will follow the "Plan B" schedule when learning from home. All students will learn from home. A Safe Place to Learn is available for students who need it on their school campus.</p>	
<p>Scottsdale Online K-12 (SOL)</p>	<p>Scottsdale Online K-12's learning model for K-5 will not change. A full day of asynchronous learning with teacher support is provided to all learners.</p> <p>Scottsdale Online K-12's learning model for 6-12 will shift to 3 classes for the first 9 weeks and another 3 classes in the last 9 weeks. This means you will (for example) take 3 semester long classes in quarter 3 third quarter (Jan-Mar) and have 3 new semester long classes 4th quarter (Mar-May)</p>	
<p>Special Education Self-Contained K-12</p>	<p>In-person special education self-contained programs are full day in-person for K-12 with an early release on Wednesdays.</p>
