The Scottsdale Unified School District Nutrition Services Department will provide an opportunity for families to drive thru or walk up at several school sites to pick up meals for the children in their family between the ages of 1 and 18. Children do not need to be an enrolled student or approved for the free and reduced meal program in order to receive meals. Just simply show up! Per USDA regulations, children must be present in order for meals to be provided. Meal distribution sites will be set up outside in the parking lot at each school. If driving, please stay in your car and meals will be passed through to the driver, based on the number of children in the car.

Meals will be served March 16<sup>th</sup> – March 27<sup>th</sup>, Monday – Friday.

All meals will be available for pick up between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.

Each child present at the time of service will receive ONE breakfast meal for the current day and ONE lunch meal for the current day, with a grand total of TWO meals per child, daily.
