WHAT:

Scottsdale Unified School District (SUSD) offers publicly accessible, online data that provides the most up-to-date information on the COVID-19 status of the District. Media members are invited to review this data regularly, as it is the only official source of data for SUSD that depicts the latest available information. Included in SUSD's COVID-19 web portal, available at www.susd.org/COVID19, are:

- **Briefings:** The official copies of the District office weekly briefings to SUSD parents. This page is directly accessible at www.susd.org/Briefings.
- **Campus Closures:** In the event there is a closure of any SUSD campus, it would be listed on this page immediately. This page is directly accessible at www.susd.org/Closures.
